Room rentals include: tables (different sizes/styles available), chairs, trash pick-up, electricity provided, etc. Highchairs are available upon request.

However, **table cloths/coverings ARE NOT INCLUDED** and are the responsibility of the renter. The Summit does not provide them.

Summit on the Park Rental FAQs

Is alcohol allowed on-site? No, alcohol of any kind (beer, wine, liquor) is not permitted into the rooms.

Can you decorate the rooms? – You may decorate the rooms on your own, there are certain restrictions, please speak with the rental coordinator for more information. There can be nothing hanging from the ceilings, no confetti and no glitter. You can also refer to the rules sheet provided to you along with the contract for more information. The Summit on the Park will not provide any assistance in the decorating and will not provide ladders, step stools, etc.

Are dishes/eating utensils provided? No, the Summit on the Park does not provide any dishes or any utensils; those must be brought in on your own.

Can I bring in my own food? – Yes, food may be brought in from an outside source or from yourself. It is also strongly recommended to bring in your own ice as well. The Summit on the Park will not provide ice for drinks, etc.

Is there a kitchen available? Yes, a kitchen is available for a small flat rate fee of \$50.00 for the day. The kitchen may be only used to warm up food or keep items cold, no actual cooking can take place on site.

Can we have music or a DJ at our party? Yes, music can be brought in, as well as a DJ. Music must be appropriate and held at a reasonable volume. A table can be provided for the DJ and their equipment, however we will not provide any sort of sound equipment.

Do we have to clean when our party is over? General clean up is appreciated. Garbage cans will be in every room for trash, etc. However, our staff will set up, move tables, and tear tables down after the event is over. Room should be left in same condition it was in prior to the event.

After hour rentals available? Yes, and they are handled on a case by case basis. The Summit has to make sure that it will be able to hold the event on the date requested, as well as provide enough staff. Extra fees can be added on to after hour events to cover extra staffing costs. There are rental packages available, please speak with rental coordinator for detailed package information.

When are bookings accepted? Room/Classroom bookings are handled year round, for the most available options, call at least two weeks prior to event, to ensure availability.

Is the Summit crowded? The Summit on the Park is a public recreation facility and sometimes events, programs will be going on and may make some dates unavailable. Also the facility might have more “traffic” if another event/program is going on.
