Frequently Asked Questions

What is the swim attire policy in the aquatics center?

The swim attire policy is designed for your health, safety, and inclusion. Please follow these guidelines when visiting our facility:

- All persons entering the water are required to wear a bathing suit defined as a swim suit with a sewn in liner.
- Children not 100% potty trained must wear a swim diaper underneath their suit.
- Clothing worn for modest and/or religious reasons must be worn over a swim suit as defined above. Cover-ups must be:
 - Light in color so as not to bleed
 - Lightweight for safety reasons
 - Clean and Presentable
- Cover-up may not be denim or have exposed metal rivets, zippers, etc.

Is there a rule about parent's accompanying children in the aquatic center?

Yes, All children 12 and under must have an adult in the aquatic center at all times. Children that are less than 42" tall, wearing a lifejacket or are non-swimmers must have an adult within arms reach of them at all times (A parent can be responsible for no more than 2 children if they fall in to this category).

What is the height requirement for someone that wants to ride the Water Slide?

All guests wishing to ride the Water Slide must be at least 42" tall. Guests between 42-48" tall are required to wear a lifejacket or pass a swim test with the Aquatic Coordinator.

I would like to bring in a group to swim, do you offer group rates?

A: Yes, we offer group rates for groups of 20 or more people. To receive the group rate you must make arrangements with the Birthday Party Coordinator at least 2 weeks prior to your visit. Please call 734/394-5323 to schedule your visit.

What kind of training do your lifeguards go through?

All lifeguards and coordinators are certified Jeff Ellis International Lifeguards. In addition, the lifeguards at the Summit on the Park go through a minimum of four hours of rigorous training each month. Training for staff includes: CPR, First Aid, AED use, preventing injuries, rescues, scenario training, and much more. Jeff Ellis also conducts a minimum of four unannounced audits throughout the year to ensure staff members are at a test ready skill level at all times.
