Frequently Asked Questions

How do I go about booking a party?

Contact the party coordinator at 734/394-5323. She will be glad to go over all your party options and set up a party perfect for you, your child, and the participants.

How far in advance do I need to book my party?

All parties must be booked at least two weeks prior to the party date. A \$50 Nonrefundable Deposit is required for all parties and must be received two weeks prior or the party will be cancelled.

Is a deposit required for my party?

Yes, a \$50 Nonrefundable Deposit is required for all parties and must be received two weeks prior or the party will be cancelled. If there is no damage to the room the deposit will be credited toward the final price of the party.

What are the rules about parent accompaniment in the aquatic center?

All children 12 and under must have an adult in the aquatic center at all times. Children that are less than 42" tall, wearing a lifejacket or are non-swimmers must have an adult within arms reach of them at all times (A parent can be responsible for no more than 2 children if they fall in to this category).

Are there things for little kids to do in the aquatic center?

Yes, the leisure pool features shallow water geysers, a play structure with two kid's slides, and a series of interactive play troughs. Small children can ride in the lazy river when wearing a lifejacket and accompanied by an adult in the water.

What does the Party Hostess do?

The party hostess is responsible for ensuring the room is prepared for your party, assist in serving food, cake, or punch, and clean the room after the event. If it is an Aquatic Party she will escort your party to and from the aquatic center. If it is a Build-A-Buddy party she will lead the children through the craft project.



Do you have other food options?

Several of the packages include cake, punch, or pizza, but we do offer guests the opportunity to order meals from Continental Catering Company. A menu will be provided and must be returned at least a week prior to the party date. Items vary from tacos to popcorn chicken and much more. Guests are also welcome to bring their own food and drinks.

Why do you require a parent to child paid ratio?

Summit on the Park staff is trained to assist in the coordination of your party and the lifeguards are trained to prevent injuries. Direct and constant supervision of your child and the participants in your party is the responsibility of the parents.

What if I would like to change something related to my party?

You can make adjustments to theme and food up to one week prior to the party. Adjustments to day and time must be made at least two weeks prior to the party.

What payment methods do you accept?

We accept cash, check, or credit cards (Visa and Mastercard). All final payments must be made within the last fifteen minutes of the party.

What if I schedule a Splash Pad Party and it is bad weather that day?

You are welcome to utilize the Summit on the Park aquatic center, schedule permitting. However, you will be charged the Aquatic Party rates.

Can I substitute pizza for cake?

You can substitute pizza for cake; you will be charged an additional fee to cover the costs of the pizza. Price is dependant on the number in attendance.

Can I substitute an hour in the pool for an hour in the bouncer?

You are welcome to add on bouncer time to a party. Unfortunately the bouncer rates are set whether or not you utilize the entire time. The fee will be added on to your overall party total.
